## **NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

## ANGUS COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING) (ON-STREET PARKING) (DECRIMINALISED ENFORCEMENT) (No.6) ORDER 202x

Angus Council hereby propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose of:

- introducing 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions to improve visibility and prevent obstructions at the following junctions:-Bruce Road/Townhead Road, Bruce Road/Noran Avenue, Culloden Road/Strachan Street/Harry Farmer Close/Sidney Street, East Mary Street/Millgate Loan, Matthew Kerr Place/Matthew Kerr Place, Stobcross/Robert Street, Townhead Road/Noran Avenue, all Arbroath: Dronley Road/Sidlaw Gardens, Birkhill; Kinloch Street, Carnoustie; Bankhead Terrace/Lochside Road, Glenclova Terrace/Glenclova Laurelbank/Lyninghills, all Forfar; Hospital Road/Access to Hillside Primary School, Hillside: Gordon Park/Park Place, Knowehead Crescent/Slade Gardens. Thrums Gardens/Prosen Road, all Kirriemuir: Terrace/Dalhousie Street, Marine Drive/South Union Street, all Monifieth: Broomfield Road/Broomfield Road, Glenesk Avenue/Nursery Road, Panmure Place, all Montrose; Commercial Street/South Street, Newtyle.
- introducing 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions to relieve congestion and maintain general access and free traffic flow in the following roads:-Drumachlie Loan, Esk Park, all Brechin; Castle Street, Friockheim; Nursery Road, Montrose; Kirk Wynd, Kirriemuir; Nursery Road, Panmure Place, Traill Drive, all Montrose.
- introducing 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions to protect access to premises, car parks, etc. in the following road:-Newbigging Drive, Arbroath.
- introducing 'Loading Only' bays, Mon Fri, 6.00am 8.30am within the following road:-Castle Street, Forfar.
- introducing 'No Stopping, Mon Fri, 8.00am 4.30pm' School Keep Clear restrictions preventing the stopping of vehicles at set times of the day to improve road safety for children in the following road:-B965 Farnell Road, Friockheim.
- Removing 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions which are no longer necessary in the following roads:-Guthrie Hill (Clancys Way), Smithy Croft (David Ford Way) all Arbroath.
- Removing 'No Waiting, Mon Fri, 8.00am 5.30pm' restrictions which are no longer necessary in the following road:-Craig Crescent, Ferryden, Montrose.

 Removing 'No Stopping, Mon - Fri, 8.00am - 4.30pm' School Keep Clear restrictions which are no longer necessary in the following road:-B965 Farnell Road, Friockheim.
