

ANGUS COUNCIL (A94 PERTH - COUPAR ANGUS - FORFAR) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION
OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 23rd October 2023, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so that carriageway resurfacing works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on 30 October 2023 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of two weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

These works will be carried out during the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 have been organised in conjunction with Amey who are carrying out over night works on the A90(T) between the 94 Glamis Road and A926 Kirriemuir Road junctions.

The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving and waiting on A94 Perth - Coupar Angus-Forfar 50m west of its junction with B9127 Douglstown - Inverarity - Carmyllie - Arbroath Road eastwards for a distance of 2.7km or thereby between the hours of 09:00 and 16:00

The alternative route eastbound is B9127 Douglstown - Inverarity - Carmyllie - Arbroath Road, A90(T) Edinburgh to Aberdeen Trunk Road. The Alternate route eastbound is A94 Perth Coupar Angus Blairgowrie, A928 Kirriemuir - Glamis - Todhills A926 Blairgowrie - Kirriemuir - Forfar A90(T) Edinburgh to Aberdeen. The reverse route applies. Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles to be maintained at all times.
