Police Report

Assessment period – 07/06/2023 – 16/08/2023

There were 13 calls received in respect of Tealing and surrounding area in this assessment period.

Angus Councillors Report

Angus Council has been in recess - no updates at present.

Field 440M East Of Cross Roads Cottage Balnuith Tealing: no update at present Static Caravans: Cllr. BW to check the rules on static caravans and the planning application process.

Traffic through the village: speed of traffic still an issue. Signage - positive reinforcement may have been a better choice.

Resident Issues

Tealing 400kV substation: Overhead lines - upgrade from 275kV to 400 kV - SD expressed her concerns regarding the proposed upgrade. TCC stated that SD was the first local resident to attend a TCC meeting regarding the proposal and as a result members of TCC had not given a collective response but had personally responded to the consultation. Cllr. BW stated that Angus Council had facilitated the extension of the public consultation feedback to 28 July. Cllr. BW also advised local resident SD to contact local MSP Graeme Dey with any further queries. TCC also stated that there were campaign groups to get in touch with regarding the proposal.

Local Bus Service 139: - TCC explained to SD that a meeting was held with TCC and Angus Council representatives and that following the result from the public consultation a public meeting will be held with local residents. TCC have been assured that the current service will continue until a new service is in place.

Active Travel Feasibility Survey: Path/Cycle Path - Safe Route to Schools - SD expressed her concern regarding the proposed route, the lack of direct communication with residents affected and the problems that are caused by the school traffic. Cllr. BW explained the importance of a safe route to school for the pupils and the lack of such adds to the issues with school traffic. Any feedback received through the feasibility survey will be taken into consideration to facilitate the safe route decided.
