- GG has spoken with Angus Alive, and they have said that nothing has been decided yet.
- GG has also written to Councillors in his capacity as an individual to ask for further information and clarity on what is happening. He has been given no further information.
- It was felt the MNCC should seek further clarity from the Councillors regarding the 'master plan' surrounding the Levelling Up funding application. This request will be sent to the Councillors and Angus Alive.
