Notice is hereby given that on 13 November 2023 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose of Scottish Water utility works, on the carriageway

The Order will come into force from 20 November 2023 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of four weeks.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the waiting of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s):

Prohibition of Waiting & Loading

- **a) Borrowfield Road, Montrose:** on the south west side of the carriageway from its junction with Renny Crescent north westwards for a distance of 40m or thereby.
- **b) Newmanswalls Avenue, Montrose:** on the east side of the carriageway from its junction with Newhame Road, north eastwards for a distance of 89. Or thereby.
- **c) Renny Crescent**: on the south east side of the carriageway from a point 80m from its junction with Borrowfield Road south westwards for a distance of 25m or thereby.
