- 1. Joanna reported that sadly we shall be losing our Head Teacher Sandra Hood within the next few weeks. She has taken up a position as Joint Head Teacher at Tealing and Strathmartine Schools and Inversity PS will have an Acting Head Teacher.
- 2. The Breakfast Club will be starting again soon as someone has been appointed to run it.
- 3. A problem facing the school is if they lose access to the Church for holding their productions, end of terms services etc they are restricted from holding them in the school hall because of a cap on numbers due to fire regulations.
- 4. Joanna brought to our attention that one of the parents of children attending the school comes from Forfar and is very concerned about the Planning Application by Scotia Homes to close the northbound exit from the A90 at Lochlands Junction. Members of CC **agreed** to look further into this.
- 5. The children of Inverarity PS have now achieved their Silver Award as a Rights Respecting School. Many, many congratulations to the children and teachers for all their hard work from all CC members.
