

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (NCN1 CYCLE TRACK AT ELLIOT, ARBROATH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN AND PEDAL CYCLE PASSAGE)  
ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 22 December 2023, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, so that improvement works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on 11 January 2024 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of three weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all pedestrian and pedal cycle traffic from passing along the National Cycle Route No. 1 at Elliot Links, Arbroath from its junction with the Balcathie railway level crossing extending westwards for a distance of 200 metres or thereby.

The alternative route for pedestrians and cyclists is via Dundee to Arbroath (A92) and East Haven to Fauldiehill (C61) roads. (The reverse route applies.)
