

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Angus Council Election of a Councillor Ward 6 – Arbroath West, Letham and Friockheim

1. A by-election is to be held to elect one councillor to the Arbroath West, Letham and Friockheim multi-member ward of Angus Council.
2. Nomination forms can be downloaded from the Angus Council website www.angus.gov.uk or may be obtained from the Election Office, Digital Reprographic Unit, Sylvie Way, Orchardbank Business Park, Forfar, DD8 1AY or by calling 01307 491781. This office is open for the issue and delivery of nomination papers on weekdays from 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) by appointment.
3. Completed nomination forms must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the above address on any weekday after the publication of this notice **but not later than 4pm on Thursday 21 March 2024**.
4. If more than one valid nomination is received, an election will be held, and voting will take place between 7am and 10pm on **Thursday 25 April 2024**.
5. Applications to register to vote **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at William Wallace House, Orchard Loan, Forfar, DD8 1WH by **Tuesday 9 April 2024**. Applications can also be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

Postal or proxy voting

1. Any elector may apply for a postal or proxy vote at this election.
2. New applications to vote by post and applications to amend or cancel an existing postal or proxy vote **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at William Wallace House, Orchard Loan, Forfar, DD8 1WH by **5pm on Wednesday 10 April 2024**.
3. New applications to vote by proxy at this election **must** reach the Electoral Registration Officer at William Wallace House, Orchard Loan, Forfar, DD8 1WH by **5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024**.
4. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election, i.e. made after the **Wednesday 17 April 2024** deadline on the grounds of; disability suffered after that deadline (or, for applicants who suffered a disability before the deadline, their disability meant that they could not reasonably have made an application in time), work/service reasons, being detained in a hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 or for Scottish prisoners serving a sentence of 12 months or less, must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer at the address below **by 5pm on Thursday 25 April 2024**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024**.
