


4	Cllr McDonald and Cllr Cheape were present for meeting and provided the following update.

5.4	ANGUSalive Update
	Nicola Barbour provided the following feedback which SN briefed out.
	• Aquapark: Now as you will be aware up and running, terrific weather so we have been blessed with great numbers over the first couple of weekends. There has been increased footfall in the park at weekends, which Byzantium are loving, however does add some additional pressures on resources/tech team for the clean up on Mondays. This has been addressed with staff and should mitigate against some of the bin/toilet pressures.
	Ranger updates: Huw Streater
	<ul> <li>Monikie and Newbigging Forest Schools: Two 10-week Forest School programmes in Monikie Country Park. Countryside Ranger George and Activity Instructor Emily have been collecting students from Monikie Primary and walking to site in the north woods. The groups have been exploring imaginative play, building community and teamwork skills, and working on nature connection through bushcraft, nature-based activities, woodland games, and working with tools on practical tasks.</li> </ul>
	• <b>Primary School Environmental Education sessions:</b> The Countryside Rangers have been carrying out 6-week spring/summer season schools programmes with local primary schools around South Angus. These programmes have us visiting primary schools and carrying out a range of activities in the schools' grounds including habitat improvements like tree planting and pond restoration, ecological surveying, tool work and practical skills, and outdoor games and activities.
	• <b>Public Volunteering Days:</b> The Rangers will be hosting seasonal one-off volunteering days at Monikie and Crombie Country Parks. These will be focussed on dealing with some of the environmental issues the parks are facing. The first session will be to tackle the Himalayan Balsam in the woods west of Panmure Road. Himalayan Balsam is an invasive non-native species and stopping its spread before it reaches the Country Park is vitally important for preserving the biodiversity of the park. The dates for these sessions will be listed in the What's On guide, promoted on our social media, and will appear on posters around the parks, and we will send some information directly to MNCC also once the dates are confirmed.
