Police update

11 calls to the Strathmartine area during this assessment period.0 crimes were recorded.

Emerging issues locally:

Police warn the local community against using door step traders and encourage the use of reputable tradesmen with reviews.

Police encouraging locals to join Neighborhood Watch Scotland to get email reports of suspicious activity and updates on crime in the area.

Feedback from Community Council to Police Scotland:

Group agreed it would be useful to understand the nature of the calls to Police. Do they relate to one theme? Group members report 10-12 young people going down bridle path nightly. No reports of crime but of concern re vandalism etc.

Roads

Major concerns continue to be highlighted by residents regarding the traffic calming measure which has been put in place on Strathmartine Road. Norma Munnoch met with 2 Road Safety officers on site to see speed of traffic and danger posed. Safety Officers advised this is a trial and they would continue to monitor speed in the area. J & A Scott highlighted that the island is in violation of 2 rules within the Highway Code:

- Rule 162 Before overtaking you should ensure the road is sufficiently clear ahead
- Rule 166 DO NOT overtake if there is any doubt, or where you cannot see far enough ahead to be sure it is safe. For example, when you are approaching a corner or bend.

Norma will continue to follow up with Roads Team and J Scott will also email.

L Riddle suggested we also use 20 signs on bins in the village to remind drivers. We will ask Angus Council if they can supply these or if they have to be purchased.

Community Resilience Forum – Update

Next steps are to test all the equipment, engage with volunteers and liaise with residents to develop our emergency plan. We'll aim to have some events in August to show people the equipment.
